Use powerful adjectives and try and include similes, metaphors and personification.
Create a poster about the eruption of mount Vesuvius.	Design a device to warn of natural disasters.	Create a graph of the 10 most deadly natural disasters	Watch a video about a natural disaster with a family member and write down and reflect on your feelings after watching the footage.
