Be sure to put everything in the right place and include the furniture you have in each room.</p>	<p><b><u>Float, sink, freeze and melt</u></b> Can you set up your own investigation to find some objects or materials that will float, sink, freeze and/or melt?</p>
<p><b><u>Create an object song</u></b> Can you find some objects in your home that make interesting sounds? Put some of these together to create your own house song. You may need some family to join your band! Take a video or sound recording and share it with us!</p>	<p><b><u>Write a story about a special house</u></b> It could be a magical house with secret passageways. An old house with lots of secrets to find. One with a treasure hunt and clues to follow. Or another idea of your own!</p>	<p><b><u>Make your own Base 10</u></b> Can you create your own tens and ones resources using some different materials? Perhaps you could use sticks for tens and acorns for ones! Take some photos using your Base 10 to do some maths questions!</p>	<p><b><u>Research a home from a different time</u></b> Research a home from a different period in time or place in the world that we are not covering at school. You could look into the homes of Vikings, or Romans or look at what homes are like in a different country, hot or cold.</p>
<p><b><u>Your dream house</u></b> Use materials of your choice to create a model of your dream house. You could just focus on the outside or include the inside as well.</p>	<p><b><u>Write a poem</u></b> Write an acrostic poem about homes. It could be homes in general, your own home, one you have seen or your dream home.</p>	<p><b><u>Create a shape picture of your house</u></b> Using only traditional shapes, can you create a picture of your house? You could either draw this in 2D or 3D. As a challenge, can you label all of the shapes you use?</p>	<p><b><u>Do some baking!</u></b> The Great Fire of London started in a baker's shop on Pudding Lane.
